Sunday 20th May 2018

The Regulations

Run under Waiver of Permit issued by the RIAC

- 1 The event is open to:
Brighton Class: Eligible three and four wheeled vehicles manufactured prior to 31st December 1904.
Centenary Class: Three and four wheeled vehicles manufactured between 1st January 1905 and 31st December 1918.
Motorcycles: Manufactured before 31st December 1918.
- 2 Eligibility for the RIAC Pioneer Run will be assumed to be valid on receipt of the signed declaration on the official Entry Form declaring the vehicle to be eligible for the Class entered. Participants should have relevant and recognized supporting documentation, providing clear proof of eligibility, available both before and after the Run in case any query or dispute should arise. It shall be the participant's responsibility to satisfy the Organisers (RIAC) as to the eligibility of their vehicle in the event of a query or dispute. The Organisers and their Agents shall be the sole arbiters of eligibility in the case of a query or dispute.
- 3 The route for the event shall be approximately 95 kms in length of a non-demanding nature.
- 4 The route will be defined in a clear manner by arrows posted at all junctions requiring a change of direction. It is not intended that navigation of the route will be of a demanding nature. As a back-up, a map of the route will be provided.
- 5 It is a condition of entry that all participants and their vehicles comply with the requirements of the Irish Road Traffic Acts with special emphasis on the insurance and Licensing Regulations. Participants must also have a valid Driving License covering the driving of their vehicle.
- 6 The entry fee for the event is €75.00 (£65.00) per vehicle and includes the following:

- 7 Entries shall open on publication of these regulations and close at the normal entry fee of €75.00 (£65.00) at 17.00 hrs on Friday 4th May 2018. Entries received after Monday 7th May and before Monday 14th May 2018 will be charged at the higher rate of €90.00 (£78.00).
Only fully completed and paid up entries will be accepted.
- 8 Entries should be sent to: The Royal Irish Automobile Club Pioneer Run, 34 Dawson Street, Dublin 2.
- 9 A limited number of additional tickets for the Lunch will be available for purchase in advance from the organizers at a cost of €35.00 (£30.00) per head. These will be available on a strictly 'first come' basis.
- 10 There will be overnight parking (night of Saturday 19th May) for participating vehicles, trailers and tow cars at Barberstown Castle Hotel. This will be in a defined area and is not covered. We would ask the assistance of all entrants in parking trailers, cars, etc. to ensure the optimum, safe usage of the space available. Whilst the organizers will arrange for security of the defined parking area, **we strongly recommend immobilising trailers.** The organisers will not be liable for any losses or damage howsoever caused to any vehicle or property.
