**The 2026 RIAC Pioneer Run will be held on
Friday, Saturday and Sunday 12-14 June.**

This event is for antique and veteran vehicles (pre-1919) only, and for flat tank motorcycles.

We are celebrating the 125th anniversary of the Irish Automobile Club, and the 120th anniversary of the first IAC Automobile Trials.

The Irish Automobile Club - as it was first known - was formed at a meeting on 22 January 1901, and is one of the oldest motor clubs in the world. The club was awarded the "Royal" prefix to its title in recognition of the humanitarian work carried out by its members during the Great War when many Irish men, returning injured from the front, were transported to convalescent homes on members' vehicles that were converted into ambulances for this purpose. Set up to promote interests of automobilism in Ireland, its first general meeting took place in the Metropole Hotel on Sackville Street - now O'Connell Street - in Dublin on 12 March 1901. The RIAC's current Clubhouse on Dawson Street also saw the formation of the Irish Aero Club in 1909
